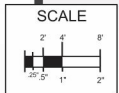
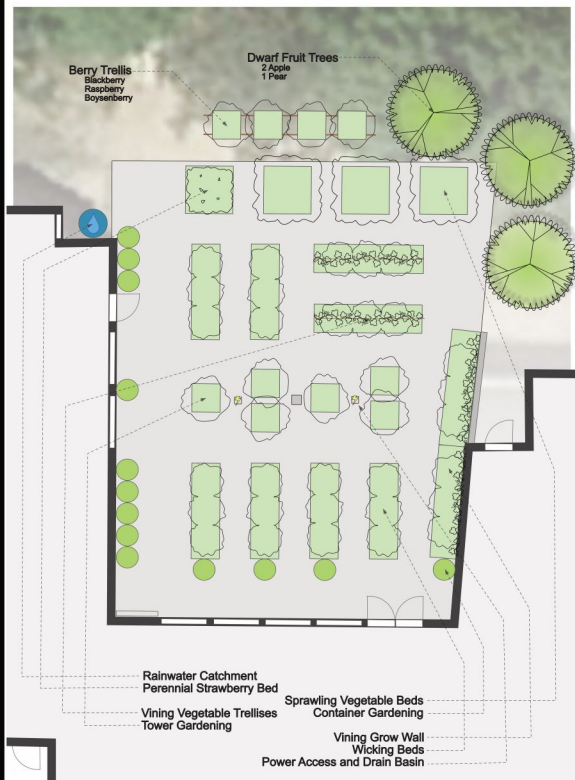
Annual Temperatures
